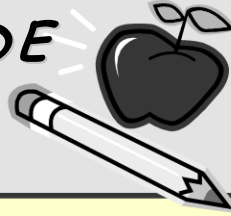


SECOND GRADE NEWS

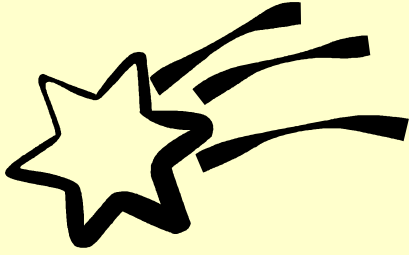
