

# What your Kindergartener is Learning:

### Language Arts:

Domain: This week we will continue talking about the Five Senses. We will learn about Helen Keller and Ray Charles. (See back for some of the vocabulary words we are covering).

There will be a quiz on the five senses on **Tuesday**.

Skills: This week we will learn the following sounds: g and i. We will learn how to write these sounds and learn how to recognize the sound.



### Math

We will keep working on Topic 2. We are still working with numbers 0-5. We will be comparing these numbers and working with greater than and less than.

### Five Senses Vocabulary:



Texture: The way something feels on the outside or surface

Remarkable: Wonderful or amazing

Blind: Unable to see; not having the sense of sight

**Sensations:** feelings caused by one of your senses

### Letter Sounds:

Learning the letter sounds is a very important kindergarten skill. This sets up students for success in learning to read. We are also learning the skill of writing each sound.

Each night it is important to look through your child's folder to see which sound we learned. Many of the activities that will come home can be a great tool for practicing at
